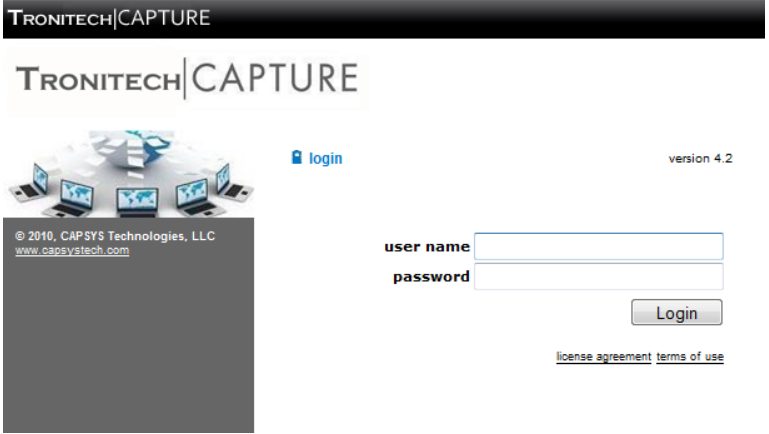


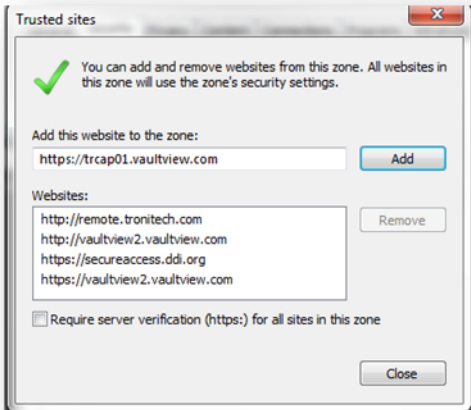
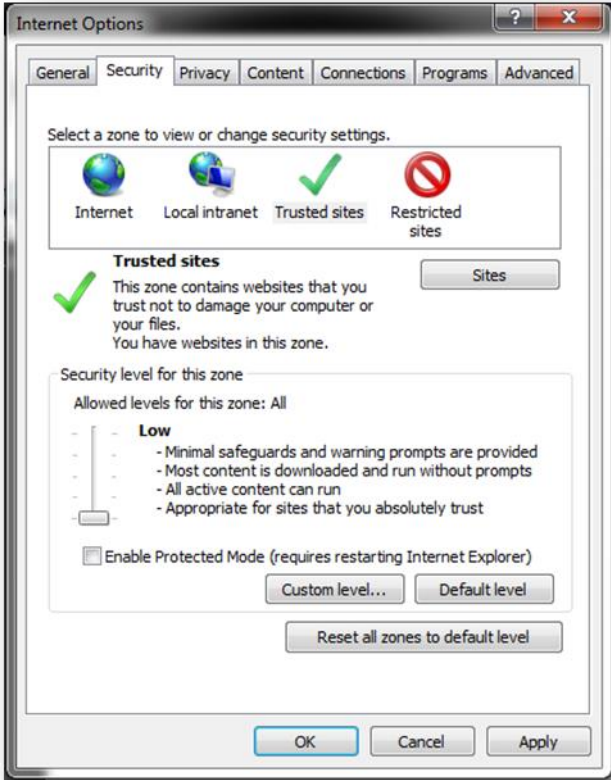


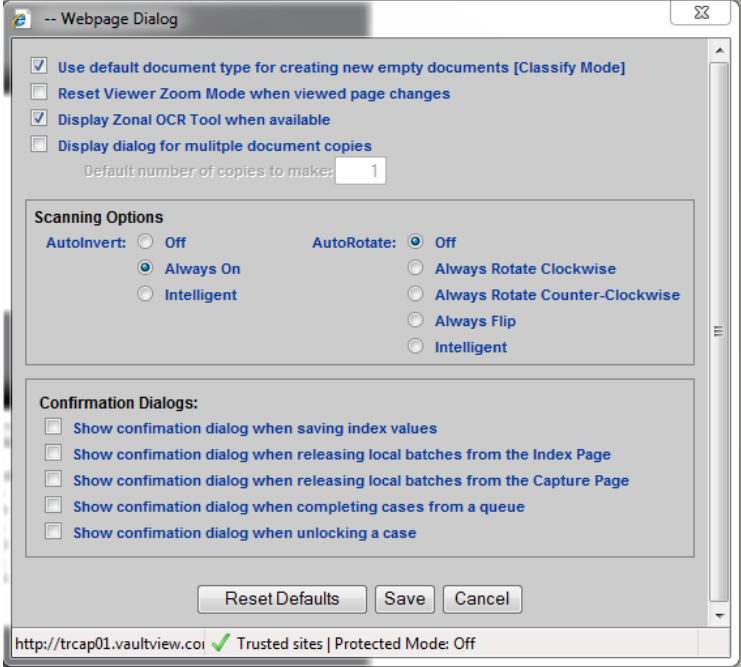
## Tronitech CAPTURE - WEB CLIENT INSTALLATION

The following documentation outlines the steps to install the Tronitech Capture Web Client.

### Installation and Configuration of the Web Client

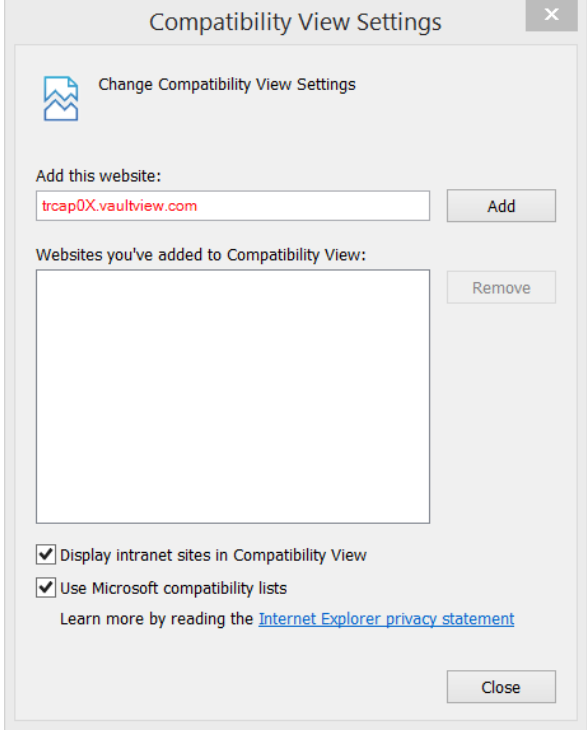
<p>1</p>	<p>Open Internet Explorer and browse to the designated website URL.</p> <p>Examples:  <a href="http://www.docteamcap.com/capsys">http://www.docteamcap.com/capsys</a></p> <p><i>Note: Your URL may be different from the URL listed above. If you have an onsite installation of Tronitech Capture please see your local administrator, or contact Tronitech Technical Support for more information or help in determining your specific website URL.</i></p>	
<p>2</p>	<p>In Internet Explorer, go to the Tools Menu and select Internet Options.</p>	
<p>3</p>	<p>Go to the Security tab.</p>	
<p>4</p>	<p>Click on Trusted Sites.</p>	
<p>5</p>	<p>Click the Sites button.</p>	

<p>6 You should see the Tronitech Capture website address under the “Add this website to the zone:” text box as shown below. Go ahead and click the Add button to add the Tronitech Capture website as a Trusted Site. (You may need to uncheck the “Require server verification https:// for all sites in this zone” check box.)</p>	
<p>7 Click the Close button.</p>	
<p>8 Now you are back to Internet Options. Adjust the “Security level for this zone” by moving the slider bar down to “Medium-Low” or “Low” setting. You may have to click the “Default level” button to enable the slider. Your screen should like the one below. <i>Note: If you do not see the Security Slider Bar, click the “Default Level” button to restore the slider back to the default settings. Then adjust accordingly.</i></p>	
<p>9 Click “Apply”</p>	

10	Click "OK"
11	Login to the Tronitech Capture website with your provided username and password.
12	The initial login will take a few minutes as the website must first download the Tronitech Capture Web Client installation package from the website to your computer.

Internet Explorer Compatibility Mode

In Internet Explorer 11 you must also enable Compatibility Mode for the Tronitech Capture website.	
1	In Internet Explorer, Go to Tools and select Compatibility Mode.
